Online @ C9

Prior to Christmas break the principals were asked to approve IVY Tech dual credit courses for the Online @ C9 program. The approval would allow students to use these courses to be counted as the high school courses listed on the chart. To date the following schools have approved the IVY Tech Dual courses: Perry Meridian, Indian Creek, Franklin Central, Beech Grove, Greenwood, Southport, Franklin Community.

The "Online at Central Nine Program is scheduled to start in the Fall of 2012. The team had an opportunity to review the program guide and application. Ms. Lauren Kruger, daughter of Dr. Wendy Kruger, spoke about her experiences as a CTE student who took online dual credit courses while in high school during the principals and curriculum directors meeting. Ms. Kruger was a broadcasting CTE student that had the opportunity to earn 33 college credits in high school. Ms. Donaldson commented that the guidance counselors will be provided with a list of recommended students from Central Nine teachers along with those students who have completed the application.

Career Pathways
