Meeting Notes

Monday, February 6, 2012; 1:15 PM

All superintendents were in attendance.

Dr. Hagen reviewed the Governing Board agenda, highlighting the following items:

Property update, audit report, summary judgment, Greenwood Chamber, Building Trades, evaluation tool, and CVS. The group supported the chamber appointment. They shared insights about their teacher evaluation instruments and were fully supportive of the CVS partnership. Questions were answered about the money for the corner property and potential uses were discussed. Having access to the campus other than the highway is met with strong support.

In other business:

Dr. Hagen reported that the Online @ Central Nine initiative is a strong relationship with Ivy Tech and that they are excited about the possibilities for students. He noted that an MOU was being signed by all principals detailing which classes would substitute for high school credits. We will supplement the Ivy Tech course with the senior project requirement for Greenwood students with our in-house English teacher. Nearly 70 students have been referred, however there is much work being done to overcome a perception that this is a 'recovery' option, which it is not.

Central Nine is hosting two workshops on Feb 29th on the new pathways initiatives through the State. DOE will have a representative here to facilitate the workshop. All counselors and curriculum individuals have been invited and strongly encouraged to attend.

A discussion about staffing projections occurred and the consensus was that the schools seemed to have made all of the cuts they were planning to make in previous years with no anticipation of further reductions.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 2:15 PM.
