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This Month's Highlights

The **Central Nine Adult Education Division** is pleased to announce the start of COMPASS Prep classes for adult learners. The classes will be held Monday – Thursday 9:00am-12:00pm and 4:00pm-6:00pm at Central Nine. These classes will help prepare adult learners for the COMPASS assessment. The Adult Education Division has become a COMPASS testing site and will be able to COMPASS test Adult Education students.

The **Adult Basic and Continuing Education** Program has already enrolled over 514 students for the spring semester. These adult learners have been provided with services related to GED Testing, GED/ESL classes, GED Practice Testing, and Adult Continuing Education courses. These services have generated over \$79,000.00 in revenue since December 2011.

Central Nine's Adult Basic Education Program has provided adult basic education services to over 632 students to date with new students enrolling regularly. The program provides online GED preparation services for up to twenty-five students at a time. The program also partners with Employ Indy and WorkOne Franklin to provide adult basic education services and adult career pathway programming.

Starting on March 9, 2012, **Central Nine will add a third English as a Second Language class in Perry Township**. This class is a partnership with the Burmese American Community Institute (BACI) and its Executive Director, Mr. Elaisa Vahnie.
