Meeting Notes

Monday, April 9, 2012; 1:15 PM

Dr. Hagen reviewed the Governing Board agenda, highlighting the following items:

Master Teacher candidate, outsourcing law enforcement and Sickels settlement. He emphasized the extremely high qualifications of the (Master Teacher) candidate and the potential this person has to make positive improvements in instruction across the campus. Dr. Hagen explained the current CERT program operations and noted that the expansion of law enforcement is a natural fit with their emergency response objectives. He then briefly reviewed the Sickels case of non-renewal and subsequent lawsuit, reminding everyone about what has transpired.

Mr. Sontag inquired about the land lease agenda item, then offered some insights about various properties Clark-Pleasant cash rents.

In other matters, Dr. Hagen noted that enrollment is strong overall but will likely have two or three programs that could be condensed to only morning or afternoon. C9 is working daily with counselors on enrollment and they have been extremely cooperative. They are also very appreciative of the new process we implemented with rapid turn-around on placement and program vacancies. We ended up not having to schedule too many students into classes that were their second choice. He then noted a new chart that helps understand the State's career pathways will be distributed to curriculum directors in the next couple of weeks. This will have good information about how the various classes are sequenced and how they are reimbursed for additional funding. The State is still determining a few of the compensation details.

Superintendents were able to share updates about their teacher evaluation plans and thoughts regarding impending discussions on compensation packages. With much of this still very speculative, the next few months should provide interesting perspectives from the various groups.

The next meeting is scheduled for Monday, May 7th at 1:15 PM. There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 2:00 PM.
