





Cancer Resource Network (CRN) is a multi-layered approach to assist cancer patients with the navigation of their cancer journey, including information about treatment options. In addition, our comprehensive resource

database offers referrals to services not only provided by the ACS but other organizations within the community.

### **Find Cures**

The American Cancer Society is the largest source of private, nonprofit cancer research funds in the United States. The Society awards approximately \$150 million in new research grants annually through its disciplined peer review process - a process so successful that 46 ACS grantees have gone on to achieve science's highest honor, the Nobel Prize. In total, more than \$3.6 billion has been invested in research since 1946. In the Great Lakes Division, approximately \$20-\$25 million in grants are funded annually at research facilities such as Indiana University, Michigan State University, Notre Dame, Purdue University, University of Michigan, Van Andel Institute, and Wayne State University/Karmanos Cancer Institute.
