This Month's Highlights

The **Adult Basic and Continuing Education** Program provided or will provide services for over 758 students since July 1, 2012! These services have generated over \$67,222 in revenue. Central Nine Career Center provides the residents of our district with services related to GED Testing, GED/ESL classes, GED Practice Testing, Proctoring Services, NCCT Testing, and Adult Continuing Education on-campus and online courses.

The AdultThe Region 5 Adult Education Consortium approved Central Nine's request to add Bookkeeper and Medical Coder Certification Programs. These are two new programs that Central Nine will offer as approved programs on the Indiana Department of Workforce Development INTraining website.

The **Central Nine Adult Education Division** is pleased to report that the GED preparation/ESL courses at the Martinsville Public Library, Job Corps, and Edinburgh Correctional Facility (at Camp Atterbury) have begun. The class at the Edinburgh Correctional Facility class will be partially funded by the Indiana Department of Corrections (\$7,500).

The **Central Nine Adult Education Division** was recently awarded \$8,000 from Interlocal Association to assist in offering GED preparation classes in Morgan County at the Martinsville Library. We are grateful to Central Indiana Regional Workforce Board (Region 5) for approving the funds to help offer this class. The class started on September 18, 2012.

These new partnerships will provide GED preparation classes for the residents of these areas. **Central Nine's Adult Basic Education Program** provided adult basic education services to over 784 adult learners during the 2011-12 school year. Since July 1, 2012, the Adult Basic Education Program has already registered more than 465 adult learners! The adult education program is securing locations to expand in Marion and Johnson counties.

The Adult Education Division is excited about all of the new program offerings and services that will be provided for the residents within our district.
