Student Services Coordinators are continuing to meet with students and parents having issues. Scheduling for next program year is beginning. 72 students earned the Governor's Work Ethic Certificate this year. They were celebrated at Awards Day where they received their certificate signed by Governor Holcomb, and they were presented with a teal cord to wear at their partner school graduation ceremony. Dual credit grades were submitted to Ball State, Ivy Tech, Trine and Vincennes Universities. 41 Students were inducted into the National Technical Honor Society for 2020-2021. We have collaborated with Clark Pleasant Schools, Franklin Community Schools to host a Johnson County Job Fair on June 10, 2021. Central Nine is assisting with the planning, registration and promotion of the event.
