

# HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS **STARTING FALL 2021**

### **ARE MASKS REOUIRED?**

- According to Indiana Department of Health guidelines, masks are recommended indoors for all unvaccinated individuals. At Central Nine, masks are recommended for unvaccinated individuals (but not required).
- At any time, under the direction of the Johnson County Health Department, masks may be required.

#### WHAT HAPPENS IF I TEST POSITIVE?

• Positive cases will require a 14-day guarantine.

## WHAT IS THE PROCESS FOR CONTACT TRACING?

- Students and faculty who are contact traced will need to guarantine for 14 days unless they are asymptomatic **and** vaccinated.
- If a student or faculty member has been contact traced, he/she will have the opportunity to opt out of a 14-day quarantine by providing proof of vaccination.

## WILL THERE BE AN ONLINE OPTION AT CENTRAL NINE?

• No. Central Nine is a Career and Technical Education (CTE) organization and must adhere to the CTE standards set by the Governor's Workforce Cabinet. This means that in-person training and laboratory experiences are required as a part of the curriculum.



#### **COVID-19 SYMPTOM CHECKER**

Fever/chills 100.4 degrees or higher Cough

Fatigue

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- Sore throat
- Sinus congestion

Loss of taste/smell

- Nausea/diarrhea
- Muscle/body aches • Vomiting Runny Nose
- Headache

Shortness of breath

- Students should check their temperatures daily before coming to campus.
- Students must be fever-free for 24 hours, before returning to campus.
- Central Nine may ask for a negative test result to return to campus if a student or faculty member is not vaccinated.
