

Revised COVID-19 Protocols - Effective, November 10, 2021

- Face masks are **strongly recommended (not required) for all individuals** while indoors.
- Contact tracing will continue at a 6-foot radius. (15 minutes or more)
- Close contacts within 6 feet of a positive case will be notified to quarantine at home for 14 days.
- All individuals identified as a close contact will <u>not</u> have to quarantine, wear a mask, or report for screening <u>if</u> they meet one of these conditions:
 - Proof of being fully vaccinated; OR
 - Proof of a documented positive COVID test within the past 3 months (no at-home test results will be accepted)
- Central Nine's campus or an individual program may need to return to a mask requirement based on the following:
 - Campus-wide positivity rate exceeds 2%.
 - Individual programs may be required to wear masks for a period of time that program maintains a 2% positivity rate in a 7-day period.
 - A school reaches significant levels of absenteeism attributable to COVID positive cases and/or quarantines. The Johnson County Health Department and the Indiana Department of Education will be notified when the absence rate reaches 20%.
 - The Johnson County advisory level in the IDH dashboard will also be monitored and the Johnson County Health Department will be consulted if a change is necessary.
