Professional Learning

Over the last couple of months we have focused on innovative strategies to improve classroom management. In the coming months we will continue to reflect on these topics, including fundraising opportunities to support a meaningful incentives program. In January, instructors will engage in a learning styles workshop and learn how this can support student success.

Ghost/Collegial Walks

Mr. Shaun Martin, Curriculum and Instruction Specialist, and Mr. Mike Quaranta are working with the Guiding Coalition to implement ghost/collegial walks during the second semester. These classroom visits are low-stakes, peer learning experiences where instructors walk through their colleagues rooms to collect ideas. They are designed to build trust, spark reflection, and share practical ideas.

Enrollment

All Central Nine juniors completed the registration process on Wednesday, December 3. On Friday, December 5, the registration process was rolled out to counselors for incoming students. The process will continue over the next few months.

Student Services Update
