Evaluation Committee / Professional Learning

The Evaluation Committee has finalized a tool that 93% of staff voted in support of for the 2026-2027 school year. The plan draws heavily from Robert Marzano's foundational research in *The Art and Science of Teaching* (2019), which emphasizes the belief that teacher development and teacher evaluation are not separate processes, but interconnected and dynamic drivers of growth.

As we look forward to next year's professional learning, many sessions will focus on elements from the new Teacher Professional Growth and Evaluation plan. Not only will there be emphasis on the ins-and-outs of the program, but individualized sessions will focus on instructional, engagement, relationship building, and classroom management strategies.

Student Services Update

- Resume workshops were conducted to help students strengthen their employability skills and prepare for future career and postsecondary opportunities.
- Continued collaboration with partner schools remained a priority through school visits and meetings with students regarding their schedules and course selections for next year.
